
ORDER

Now on this 18 day of August, 2016 comes on for hearing the matter of the awarding of the Bid for Firearms for the Washington County Sheriff's Office, and from various bids submitted, and other things, matters and proof before the Court, the Court finds:

1. That the procedure for soliciting bids was properly followed as outlined in Statute ACA 14-22-101 et seq.
2. That the lowest and most responsible bid was submitted by Cruse Uniforms and Equipment, Inc. of Springdale, AR, with options added, in the amount Thirteen Thousand, Six Hundred Fifty-Four dollars, and Thirty Two Cents. (\$13,654.32) plus applicable tax should be approved.
3. That bidder agrees to meet all specifications as outline in Bid #2016-09

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE COURT CONSIDERED, ORDERED AND AJUDGED that the awarding of the bid for firearms by Cruse Uniforms and Equipment, Inc. should be approved and confirmed in all respects.
