
ORDER

Now on this 20 day of October, 2016 comes on for hearing the matter of the awarding of the bid for Life and Accidental Death & Dismemberment Insurance for the Washington County, and from various bids submitted, and other things, matters and proof before the Court, the Court finds:

1. That the procedure for soliciting bids was properly followed as outlined in Statute ACA 14-22-101 et seq.
2. That the lowest and most responsible bid was submitted by VOYA , represented by Brown & Brown Insurance of Springdale, AR, with options added, in the amount Twenty Two Thousand, Three Hundred Eighty Six Dollars, and Forty Six Cents. (\$22,386.46) should be approved.
3. That bidder agrees to meet all specifications as outline in RFP 2016-02

It is my pleasure to inform you that the Bid review is now complete for the Group Life and AD&D for the 2017 plan year.

I received bids from two Companies, VOYA, represented by Brown & Brown of Arkansas and from The Municipal Pool administered by Ochs, Inc. of St. Paul, Minnesota.

After a careful comparison of the bid packets received, I am recommending that the Bid be awarded to Brown & Brown of Arkansas based on the following:

VOYA submitted a bid with an annual price on Washington County's 2017 Plan of \$22,386.46.
VOYA has offered Washington County a three (3) year rate lock.

The Municipal Pool submitted a bid with an annual price on Washington County's 2017 Plan of \$39,500.64.
The Municipal Pool has offered Washington County a three (3) year rate lock.

Brown & Brown is the incumbent bidder and is located in Springdale, Arkansas represented by Todd Setser and Brad Gessler. This continues to give us local contact access and service.

I have discussed this information with Lindsi and she concurs with my findings.
