This letter is to inform who it may concern; Washington County Road Department is accepting the bid from Buckley Powder over Austin Powder. Buckley Powder is our current vender and there quality of work has been great, we have developed a plan for how and where we are going to shoot each shot to best benefit the County's productivity. Also we are planning to shoot more rock out of the Marrow Crusher which Buckley actually came in lower on the bid. Although Austin Powder is 1.8% less expensive, Buckley Powders product and productivity far out way the approximant \$2,500 savings over a years' time. Also Buckley Powder is already familiar with our plan and location for shots planned for both sites.

In past years we have worked with Austin Powder, their quality of work is not up to the same standard that Buckley is. On several occasions their shots would need to be reshot to repair over blasting and under cutting. These mistakes cost the county productivity do to having to shut down crusher operation so they can fix there last shot before they can shoot again.

The Washington County Road Department would like to consider keeping Buckley Powder for this 2017 year.
