

**NOTICE OF PROVISIONAL BALLOT HEARING LETTER  
TO VOTERS WHO CAST PROVISIONAL BALLOTS IN THE  
ELECTION**

**REASON 1: SIGNED OPTIONAL VERIFICATION OF IDENTITY AFFIRMATION FOR NO VERIFICATION OF VOTER REGISTRATION (APPROVED VOTER ID)/ ID EXPIRED FOR MOR THAN 4 YEARS**

The signed provisional ballot envelope with Verification of Identity Affirmation completed at the polling site shall be delivered to the Washington County Election Commission so that the provisional ballot may be counted. If the Commission determines that the provisional ballot is invalid and should not be counted on other grounds, the voter is invited to attend an administrative hearing to bring evidence and defend the validity of your ballot.

**The meeting date is listed below. You will be notified if your ballot counted or did not count.**

**REASON 2: NO VERIFICATION OF VOTER REGISTRATION PROVIDED AND FAILED TO SIGN THE OPTIONAL VERIFICATION OF IDENTITY AFFIRMATION**

If you cast a Provisional Ballot for **failure to present Verification of Voter Registration and you possess ID, but refused to sign the OPTIONAL VERIFICATION OF IDENTITY AFFIRMATION**, you may present proof of identity to the **County Clerk** by noon of the first Monday following the election for the provisional ballot to be counted: Deadline: \_\_\_\_\_

**"Verification of Voter Registration"** is a document or photo ID card that is issued by the State, the federal government or an accredited postsecondary educational institution in Arkansas. The ID must show the name and photograph of the person to whom it was issued, and, if it has an expiration date, must not be expired more than 4 years before Election Day. Examples of acceptable proof of identity include, but are not limited to:

- An Arkansas driver's license;
- An Arkansas State ID( for example issued by the Revenue Office)
- A U.S. passport;
- A concealed carry handgun license issued by the State of Arkansas or federal government
- A U.S. military ID document (Active or Retired);
- A student or employee ID card issued by a postsecondary educational institution located in Arkansas;
- A public assistance ID card issued by the State of Arkansas or federal government;
- A voter ID card with a photo issued by the county clerk

**REASON 3: Other Reasons**

The Washington County Election Commission will set an administrative hearing to determine if your ballot will be counted for this election. You will be notified by mail concerning your provisional ballot. If your ballot did not count you are invited to attend this hearing to bring evidence and defend the validity of your ballot. If your ballot is counted then you will be notified as such.
