Overview:

The Review Committee commends the facility staff as they continue to offer inmate programming. The facility provides GED courses, life skills support, substance abuse education, parenting courses, a women's support group, as well as an on-site social worker.

The County recently increased the facility's staff level. To date, given the scope of operation, the facility has a sufficient staff level. The Review Committee commends Washington County concerning the positive update.

Health care professionals are on site 24 hours a day, allowing the inmates and staff to stay on site. Currently, the health team is composed of 1 medical doctor, 1 mental health professional, 3 nurse practitioners, 1 RN, 3 LPNs, 5 paramedics, 11 medical assistants, and 3 medicine passers. The Review Committee applauds Washington County with regard to health care services.

The current inmate population is outpacing the facility's capacity with regard to inmate housing areas. Some cell and housing areas are overpopulated. Due to the inmate population, the facility, at times, will struggle in terms of classification frameworks and housing goals. In a typical month, the facility will intake some 1,000 inmates.

Due to the inmate population, the facility appears to be aging at a more rapid pace. Due to the inmate population, the staff at times will struggle in securing required outdoor/recreation goals.

The Review Committee encourages Washington County to consider the creation of a Local Criminal Justice Coordinating Committee (LCJCC) or like mechanism. A LCJCC or like approach can assist the community, agency, and facility in terms of jail population numbers, housing plan success, and overall positive outcomes.

Jail staffers secure some 20-25 continuing education hours per year.

A number of jail officers are Part-Time II commissioned/certified law enforcement officers.

Jail supervisors are full-time commissioned/certified law enforcement officers.

On date of Review, the facility was holding 115 Washington County - ADC-bound inmates.

On date of Review, the facility was holding 30 inmates for the U.S. Marshals Service.

On date of Review, the facility was holding 16 inmates for the Madison County Sheriff's Office.

The facility is updating some plumbing fixtures as well as updating the rules/rights form.

The knowledgeable and professional staff oversee a well-operated facility.

All Adult Detention Facilities in Arkansas must comply with all applicable mandatory requirements. Failure to meet applicable requirements will cause the facility to be considered in non-compliance and subject to future action by this agency in compliance with 1185 of 2001.
