## BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF WASHINGTON, STATE OF ARKANSAS, A RESOLUTION TO BE ENTITLED:

## A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE STATE OF ARKANSAS TO REIMBURSE COUNTIES THE ACTUAL COSTS OF HOUSING AND CARING FOR STATE PRISONERS IN COUNTY JAILS.

**WHEREAS,** County jails throughout the state of Arkansas, and the Washington County Detention Center, in particular, house and care for thousands of state prisoners each year; and

**WHEREAS**, the cost to house these prisoners are approximately \$68.00 per day, but the State only reimburses the Counties \$30.00 per day; and,

**WHEREAS**, the lack of funding for the large population of State prisoners puts an enormous and unjustified burden on the County financial resources.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF WASHINGTON COUNTY, ARKANSAS:

**ARTICLE 1.** The Washington County Quorum Court respectfully requests that the Arkansas General Assembly pass an Act requiring the State of Arkansas to reimburse the various Counties for the actual cost it incurs for housing and caring for the State's prisoners, and further respectfully requests that the Governor sign the same into law.
