Thursday, February 16, 2017 6:00 p.m. Washington County Quorum Court Room

County Judge Joseph K. Wood called the meeting to order.

JP Lloyd led the prayer and pledge.

ARTICLE 1: The members of the Quorum Court express their appreciation to Karen Beeks, and commends her for 37 years of dedication and service to Washington County.


