**MINUTES OF THE
REGULAR MEETING OF THE
WASHINGTON COUNTY QUORUM COURT**

Thursday, March 16, 2017
6:00 p.m.
Washington County Quorum Court Room

JP Butch Pond called the meeting to order.

A proper motion and second was made to elect JP Pond to preside over the meeting in Judge Joseph Wood's absence. A proper motion and second was made to elect JP Eva Madison to preside and a proper motion and second was made to elect JP Harvey Bowman to preside. A motion to close nominations was unanimously adopted. Thereafter, JP E. Madison was elected to preside.

Washington County Sheriff Tim Helder led the prayer and pledge.

Acting Quorum Court Secretary Jamie Williams called the roll. Members present were JP Daniel Balls, JP Bowman, JP Robert Dennis, JP Lisa Ecke, JP Ann Harbison, JP Joe Kieklak, JP Roddy Lloyd, JP Tom Lundstrum, JP E. Madison, JP Sue Madison, JP Joel Maxwell, JP Bond, and JP Bill Ussery. JP Joe Patterson was absent.

A motion to approve the agenda as amended was unanimously adopted.

During the citizen comment time, Renee Biby spoke against the ordinance to create an exception to Washington County Code which would allow Sharon Lloyd to be employed by the County. Ms. Biby also voiced her concern regarding the management of county sewer systems. Zoey Armstrong and Autumn Gregg both thanked the Quorum Court members who help judge the 4H competitions and the Quorum Court as a whole for its continued support of the 4H program. Dawn Whittington spoke about her concerns regarding county sewer step systems.

A motion was made by JP S. Madison to approve February 9th minutes. It was properly seconded and unanimously adopted.

A motion to suspend the rules and read all ordinances and resolutions by title only was made by JP S. Madison and seconded by JP Kieklak. Said motion passed unanimously. County Attorney Brian R. Lester read the resolution titled, "A Resolution Authorizing Judi Neal to Solemnize the Marriage of Bob Jordan and Allison Anabal Walker on May 11, 2017, in Washington County, Arkansas." A motion to adopt the resolution was made by Robert Dennis and seconded by Ann Harbison. All present Quorum Court members voted to adopt the resolution. JP E. Madison then recognized Bob Jordan and Allison Anabal Walker, who were in attendance.

Resolution 2017-05, A Resolution Authorizing Judi Neal to Solemnize the Marriage of Bob Jordan and Allison Anabal Walker on May 11, 2017, in Washington County, Arkansas, was adopted.

County Attorney Lester, on second reading, then read the ordinance by title, "An Ordinance to Allow Sharon Lloyd to be Employed by Washington County and thus Create an Exception to Washington County Code §2-192(3)(A)." JP S. Madison then called a point of order to question the legality of the Ordinance. After discussion between County Attorney Lester and various members of the Quorum Court, JP E. Madison, presiding in Judge Wood's absence, ruled the Ordinance to be in violation of state law and thus invalid.

An Ordinance to Allow Sharon Lloyd to be Employed by Washington County and thus Create an Exception to Washington County Code §2-192(3)(A) was dismissed as improper.

JP Pond presented the Judge's Report in Judge Wood's absence.

A motion was then made by JP Pond to accept Judge Wood's appointment of Susan Unger to the Washington County Library Board. The motion was seconded by JP Dennis. A voice vote was called and the motion passed unanimously.

County Attorney Lester read, by title only, "An Ordinance Appropriating the Amount of \$51,970 from the Road Fund to the Road ½ Cent Sales Tax Budget for 2017." Joel Gardner then spoke to provide information, updates, and support for the ordinance. A roll call vote was called, and the votes were tallied as follows:

Ordinance 2017-15, An Ordinance Appropriating the Amount of \$51,970 from the Road Fund to the Road ½ Cent Sales Tax Budget for 2017, was adopted.

JP E. Madison gave the finance report. County Attorney Lester then read the appropriate ordinance by title, "An Ordinance Adjusting Carryover Revenues in Various Funds for 2017." There was some discussion between members of the Court regarding the ordinance. No one from the public chose to speak about this ordinance and JP E. Madison requested a roll call vote. All members of the Quorum Court that were present voted to adopt ordinance.

Appropriation Ordinance 2017-11, An Ordinance Adjusting Carryover Revenues in Various Funds for 2017, was adopted.

County Attorney Lester then read the appropriation ordinance by title, "An Ordinance Anticipating and Appropriating Revenue of \$4,000 in the Law Enforcement Grand Fund for 2017." There was neither discussion nor any public comment. The ordinance was unanimously adopted by the Quorum Court.

Appropriation Ordinance 2017-12, An Ordinance Anticipating and Appropriating Revenue of \$4,000 in the Law Enforcement Grand Fund for 2017, was adopted.

County Attorney Lester read, by title only, "An Ordinance Reducing the Amount of \$1,307,101 from Line Items in Various County Budgets and Restoring Those Funds to Unappropriated Reserves; and, Appropriating the Total Amount of \$1,194,124 from Unappropriated Reserves to Various Budget Line Items for 2016." There was some discussion regarding the discrepancy in the amounts and a scrivener's error was found in the title. The title of the appropriation ordinance was amended to reflect the correction and thus read, as amended and corrected, by County Attorney Lester as "An Ordinance Reducing the Amount of \$1,311,742 from Line Items in Various County Budgets and Restoring Those Funds to Unappropriated Reserves; and, Appropriating the Total Amount of \$1,194,124 from Unappropriated Reserves to Various Budget Line Items for 2016." JP Ecke moved the Court to adopt the ordinance as amended, which was seconded by JP Harbison. A roll call vote was taken, and all members in attendance voted to adopt the ordinance.

Appropriation Ordinance 2017-13, An Ordinance Reducing the Amount of \$1,311,742 from Line Items in Various County Budgets and Restoring Those Funds to Unappropriated Reserves; and, Appropriating the Total Amount of \$1,194,124 from Unappropriated Reserves to Various Budget Line Items for 2016, was adopted.

JP Ussery moved the Court to adopt "An Ordinance Amending Washington County Code Sections 2-18" which was properly seconded. County Attorney Lester then read the ordinance by title only. A roll call vote was called and all members voted to adopt the ordinance.

Ordinance 2017-14, An Ordinance Amending Washington County Code Sections 2-18, was adopted.



During "Other Business", JP S. Madison spoke about her concerns regarding information that she received that a decision was made to tear down the old National Guard Armory, just south of the Historic Courthouse. County Attorney Lester and Chief of Staff Carl Gales informed the Court that no such plans had been made.

JP E. Madison submitted a Committee Schedule to the Court. Following some discussion, a motion to accept the committee schedule was made by JP Dennis and seconded by JP Lundstrum. The motion passed unanimously.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT
OF THE COUNTY OF WASHINGTON,
STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE
TO BE ENTITLED:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING WASHINGTON
COUNTY CODE SECTION 2-18.

WHEREAS, the Quorum Court has been reviewing the
Washington County Code of Ordinances; and,

WHEREAS, it that section 2-18 of the Code is in need of
amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM
COURT OF WASHINGTON COUNTY, ARKANSAS:

ARTICLE 1. Washington County Code Section 2-18 is hereby
amended as follows:


Sec. 2-18. - Compensation.

- (a) Justices of the Peace ~~servng as Quorum Court members~~ shall receive per diem compensation for attending any official, regular, special or committee meeting of the Quorum Court in the sum of ~~one hundred ten dollars (\$110.00)~~ two hundred dollars (\$200.00) provided, the per diem compensation of any Justice of the Peace during any one calendar year shall not exceed the maximum amount established by the Arkansas General Assembly, of eight thousand thirty five dollars (\$8,035.00) ~~Compensation amounts are established by Act 1170 of the 83rd Arkansas General Assembly, 2001, pertaining to maximum and minimum salaries for elected County officers, and said Act is herein adopted as if set out word for word.~~
- (b) Per diem compensation is hereby defined as a per calendar day allowance, exclusive of allowable expenses, which shall be paid a Justice of the Peace for attending any official, regular, special or committee meeting or meetings of the Quorum Court during any single calendar day without regard to the duration of such meeting or meetings. However, a Justice of the Peace may receive per diem compensation for one (1) meeting a year for which the member is absent due to an emergency or for personal reasons.
- (c) ~~Beginning January 1, 1983,~~ Each Justice of the Peace shall be compensated reimbursed for travel to and from any official, regular, special or committee meeting of the Quorum Court at the ~~rate per mile established by ordinance for County officials~~ standard federal mileage rate for privately owned vehicles as established by the Internal Revenue Service as expense reimbursement. Otherwise, Justices of the Peace shall be entitled to receive reimbursement of allowable expenses incurred in the conduct of county affairs on the same terms as other elected officials and county employees, within the budgetary limits established by the Quorum Court on an annual basis.

~~(d) Attendance at a any official, regular, special or committee meeting of the Quorum Court shall be verified by roll-call by the Court Secretary. Attendance at a committee meeting of the Quorum Court shall be verified by the committee chairman, who shall file with the County Clerk written reports of those Justices attending committee meetings. Such reports shall be filed within thirty (30) days following the committee meeting.~~

~~(e) Any Justice of the Peace who shall preside over a Justice of the Peace Court, shall do so without compensation.~~

~~(f)(e) Each year that the General Assembly changes the minimum per diem compensation and the maximum yearly compensation shall result in an automatic increase of such. Pursuant to Act 942 of the 90th General Assembly, (3%) per annum shall be added to the maximum per diem compensation of Justices of the Peace as a cost-of-living adjustment.~~
