MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE WASHINGTON COUNTY QUORUM COURT

County Judge Joseph K. Wood called the meeting to order.

JP Tom Lundstrum led the prayer and pledge.

JP Harbison introduced Elizabeth Bowen, Project Manager for the Northwest Arkansas Regional Planning Commission, to give an update on the Open Space Feasibility Study. There were comments made by JP Harbison, JP E Madison and County Judge Joseph Wood.
