# MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE WASHINGTON COUNTY QUORUM COURT

Thursday, January 17, 2019 6:00 p.m. Washington County Quorum Court Room

County Judge Joseph K. Wood called the meeting to order.

JP Sue Madison introduced Paul Warren, Director of Church Operations for St. Joseph, to lead the prayer. JP Sue Madison led the pledge.
