

ORDER

NOW, on this 31<sup>st</sup> day of May, 2006 comes the above matter and the  
court finds:

- (1) This court has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein pursuant to Article 7 Section 28 of the Arkansas Constitution in that it is a matter of internal improvement and local concern.
- (2) That Washington County pursuant to regulations promulgated by the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality must develop a Stormwater Management Plan in certain areas of the county that have been designated as MS4's.
- (3) That failure to implement a program can result in a fine of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) per day and the time for implementation of such has passed.
- (4) That said program will not additionally burden development in the county as such is already regulated in the same manner by the State.
- (5) That the Stormwater Management Plan attached hereto and incorporated herein as if set out word for word is hereby adopted.
- (6) Any violation of this order or the program implemented herein shall result in the commencement of a civil action in this court or circuit court. Furthermore, any such violations shall be reported to the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality and the Prosecuting Attorney for violations of state law and/or regulations.
