MEETING February 17, 2021 MINUTES

A meeting of the Fourth Judicial District Drug Task Force Control Board was held on February 17, 2021. This meeting was held using Zoom due to COVID-19 and recommendations for social distancing.

The meeting was called to order by Mike Reynolds. Upon roll call, the above listed members were acknowledged present. Copies of the minutes from the January 13, 2021 meeting were distributed to all present. A motion was made by Tim Helder, and seconded by Chris Workman, to approve the minutes. The motion was approved unanimously.

A copy of the financial report for the Grant FY 2020-2021 was distributed to all present for review, period ending January 31, 2021. Financial Director Willie Newman stated the total expense to date was \$255,207.00 which included Federal-J21-004-18 \$91,319.00, Local-J21-004-18 \$ 18,264.00, and Non-Allowed-\$145,624.00.

The award documents are being finalized and will start drawing down on those March 1, 2021. The amount of that award is Federal Jag 21-\$85,051.00, State-\$49,864.00, Local-\$18,264.00.

Sergeant Tyler Moore reported on the task force's activity January 1, 2021 through January 31, 2021 and distributed a copy of statistics to all present. Moore stated that in January the task force opened 33 cases, closed 37 cases, and made 13 arrests. Moore further noted that \$6,190.00 was expended for the purchase of evidence, \$0.00 for the

purchase of service, and \$750.00 for the purchase of information. Moore stated that drugs seized during the month included: Methamphetamine, Cocaine, Marijuana, Ecstasy, and pharmaceuticals. Moore stated that 4 warrants were served. Also noted, 3 drug convictions for the month of January. The task force seized 0 vehicles and a total of \$800.00 in U.S. Currency during the month. The locations of DTF Enforcement Action for the month were: Fayetteville 14 cases, Springdale 6 cases, Farmington 2 cases, Elkins 1 case, Prairie Grove 4 cases, Washington County 3 cases, Tontitown 2 cases, and Johnson 1 case.

Other Business

No other business was brought before the Control Board.

Public Comments

Scott Mashburn: Follow-up comment regarding the task force meeting being put on the Fayetteville City Calendar sooner than a week before the meeting. Would also like to see other participating agencies put it on their city calendars.

Sarah Moore: Asked for clarification regarding the 13 arrest. If the \$800 and the guns seized from were from one person or multiple people and was it a part of the two Drug Trafficking Operations that was disrupted?

Sarah Moore provide information concerning Senate Bill 197, introduced by Senator Alan Clark, regarding asset forfeitures. Two areas of concern, that everyday people do not understand the process and would like a minimum threshold set, that we won't spend more money to bring in an asset, that would actually cost us more to bring in.

Kirk Lane: Continued the discussion regarding Senate Bill 197 in which he informed the board that it had been pulled down at the end of that hearing by Senator Clark. Part of the reason was due to information in the bill that did not fit what was really needed in Arkansas. He (Clark) left out controls and transparency that has been so vital in Arkansas current Asset Seize Program.

Lane went on to say that some agencies do have thresholds, those are set by the prosecutors in each of those jurisdictions.

Matt Durrett: We are opposing that bill (Senate Bill 197) due to some inaccuracies. **Sarah Moore:** Continue discussion on Senate Bill 197, with regards to the language concerning changing asset forfeiture from civil to criminal. With it been criminal gives the defendant the possibility of legal representation, through the civil process it does not.

Moore shared concerns regarding people that are living communally, where their property is seized as part of the investigation.

Kirk Lane, explained that a good percentage of forfeitures are giving back by the prosecutor or judge, if it is found that it is not a part of the crime or fit asset forfeiture guidelines.

Chief Mike Reynolds requested a date and time for the next meeting. The next meeting will be March 17, 2021 at 1:30 P.M. This meeting will take place remotely through Zoom due to Covid-19 and the recommendation for social distancing. The meeting was adjourned. Minutes recorded.
