A meeting of the Fourth Judicial District Drug Task Force Control Board was held on June 23, 2021. This meeting was held using Zoom due to COVID-19 and recommendations for social distancing.

The meeting was called to order by Chief Mike Reynolds. Upon roll call, the above listed members were acknowledged present. Copies of the minutes from the May 19, 2021 meeting were distributed to all present. A motion was made by Jay Cantrell, and seconded by Jeff O'Brien, to approve the minutes. The motion was approved unanimously.

A copy of the financial report for the Grant FY 2020-2021 was distributed to all present for review, period ending May 31, 2021. Financial Director Willie Newman stated the total expense to date was \$409,810.00 which included Federal_J21-004-20 \$76,557.00, Federal-J21-004-18 \$91,319.00, State-J21-004-20 \$49,864.00, Local-J21-004-20 \$18,264.00, Local-J21-004-18 \$ 18,264.00, and Non-Allowed- \$155,543.00.

Lieutenant Tim Franklin reported on the task force's activity May 1, 2021 through May 31, 2021 and distributed a copy of statistics to all present. Franklin stated that in May the task force opened 23 cases, closed 20 cases, and made 13 arrests. Franklin further noted that \$4,840.00 was expended for the purchase of evidence, \$0.00 for the purchase of service, and \$400.00 for the purchase of information. Franklin stated that drugs seized during the month included: Methamphetamine, Marijuana, Heroin, LSD, Psilocybin Mushrooms, meth lab, and pharmaceuticals. Franklin stated that 10 warrants were

served. Also noted, 3 drug convictions for the month of May. The task force seized 0 vehicles and a total of \$24,614.00 in U.S. Currency during the month. The locations of DTF Enforcement Action for the month were: Fayetteville 12 cases, Springdale 6 cases, Tontitown 1 case, Prairie Grove 3 cases, and Elkins 1 case.

Other Business

No other business brought before the Control Board.

Chief Mike Reynolds requested a date and time for the next meeting. The next meeting will be July 21, 2021 at 1:30 P.M. **at the Fayetteville Police Department**, 100 W. Rock Street, Fayetteville, AR. The meeting was adjourned.
