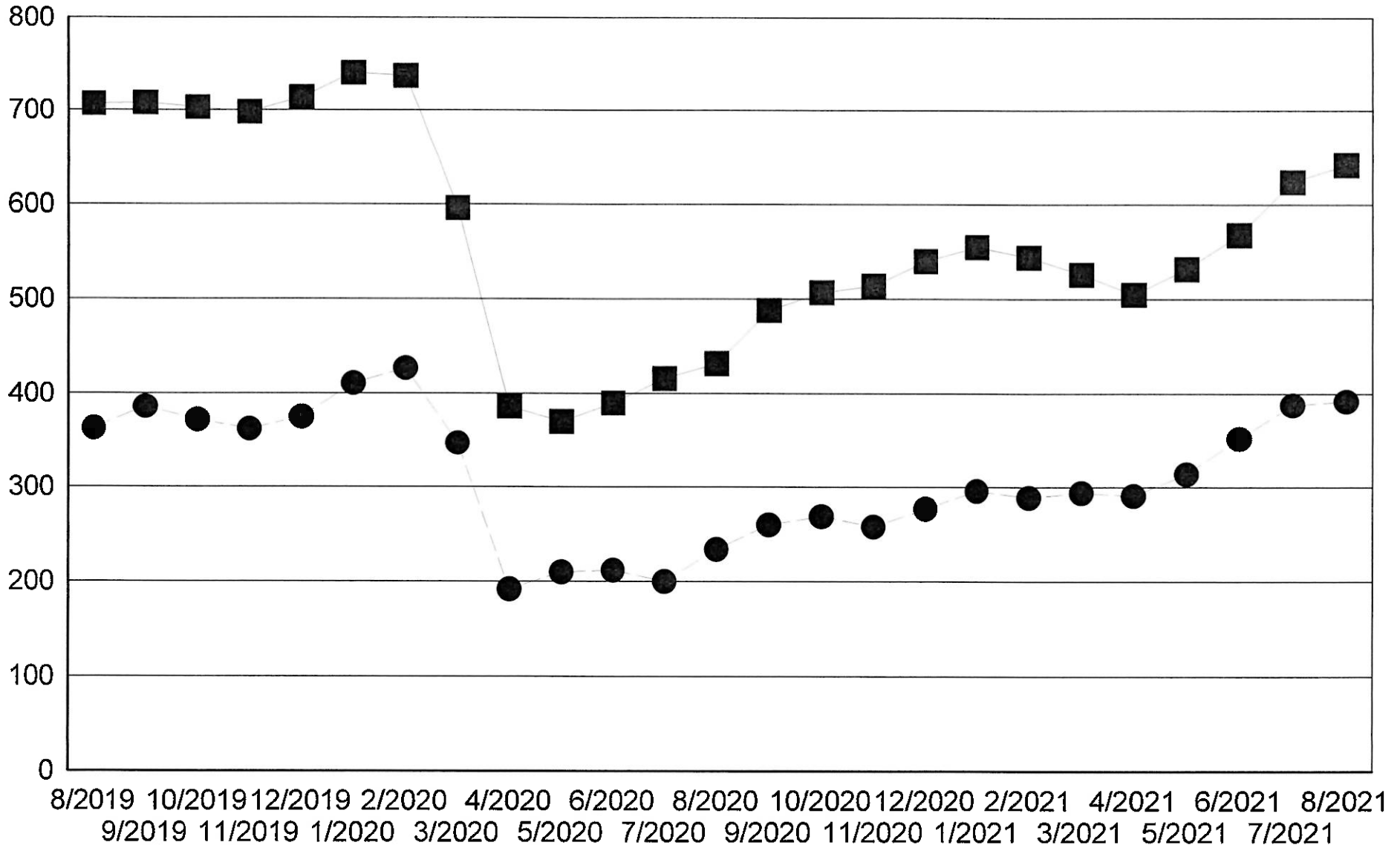

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF WASHINGTON, STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$125,000 FROM UNAPPROPRIATED RESERVES IN THE GENERAL FUND (1000) TO THE OTHER PROFESSIONAL SERVICES LINE ITEM (3009) IN THE BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS BUDGET (10000108) FOR 2021.

WHEREAS, the elevator in the Courthouse Annex is currently in need of replacement; and,

WHEREAS, the cost to replace the elevator is estimated to be \$125,000; and,

WHEREAS, to ensure that there are no further delays in the replacement of said elevator, the Quorum Court desires to appropriate money so that construction can begin as soon as a vendor is chosen pursuant to state law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF WASHINGTON COUNTY, ARKANSAS:

ARTICLE 1. There is hereby appropriated the amount of \$125,000 from unappropriated reserves in the General Fund (1000) to the Other Professional Services line item in the Buildings and Grounds Budget (10000108.3009) for 2021.

ARTICLE 2. The money appropriated herein may only be used for the replacement of the elevator at the Courthouse Annex. Any unused money shall be returned to the unappropriated reserves of the General Fund.
