



Provider-led Arkansas Shared Savings Entity

The PASSE model is a Medicaid-funded program. It does not change a person's eligibility for Medicaid, but has changed the way services are paid for by Medicaid. Each PASSE acts a lot like an insurance group that providers join to be in network, and the PASSEs cover healthcare services for their members.

Individuals' services are managed and reimbursed by the PASSEs if individuals

- are on the Developmental Disabilities (DD) Waiver
- are on the DD Waiver Wait list and get Medicaid state plan services
- live in a private DD Intermediate Care Facility
- have a Behavioral Health diagnosis and need services in addition to counseling and medication management

The goal of the PASSE system is to monitor clients' health care needs, keep them healthy, and help them reach goals.

Networks



The PASSEs will continuously build their statewide networks and finalize contracts. Network lists are updated on their websites.

Care Coordinator



They are employed by the PASSE to assist you and your family with your health care needs; must contact you monthly and meet in person quarterly; provided as part of the PASSE service package; visits are not individually billed.

Person-Centered Service Plan (PCSP)



Each of your providers has a plan of care for you, and all of those will come together into one plan called a PCSP to help meet your needs and goals.

Paid services include:

- emergency room visits & hospital services
- medications
- doctor visits
- supportive living
- medical supplies
- specialty services for behavioral health and developmental disabilities
