County Judge Joseph Wood called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

JP Sam Duncan led the prayer and pledge.

JP Sam Duncan presented the August County Services Committee Report. The County Services Committee did not meet in August due to lack of an agenda.

JP Patrick Deakins presented the August Finance & Budget Committee Report. The Finance & Budget Committee met Tuesday, July 24, 2021. There were budget reviews on the Treasurer, Collector, County Clerk, Circuit Clerk, Circuit Court VII, and Prosecuting Attorney. The Finance & Budget Committee met Thursday, July 29, 2021. There were budget reviews on the Assessor, Circuit Judge I, Circuit Judge II, Circuit Judge IV, Circuit Judge V, Circuit Judge VI, and Public Defender. The Finance & Budget Committee met Tuesday, August 10, 2021. There were reports given on the Treasurer, Employees' Insurance, and Comptroller. There were budget reviews on the Election Commission, Circuit Court III, and Circuit Court VII. The Committee approved to include in the Budget Controls an increase of 10% to the County's salary ranges and give a 3.5% merit based raise. The Committee approved eight ordinances to be forwarded to the Quorum Court.

JP Lance Johnson presented the August Jails/Law Enforcement/Courts Committee Report. The Jails/Law Enforcement/Courts Committee met on Monday, August 9, 2021. There were Statistic Reports given on the Juvenile Detention Center, Sheriff's Enforcement, and Detention. The Committee heard a presentation on the Strategic Covid Mitigation and Jail Bed Allocation. The Committee also received updates on the Community Alternative Program and from the Criminal Justice Coordinating Committee. The Committee approved three ordinances to be forwarded to the Finance & Budget Committee.

JP Lisa Ecke presented the August Personnel Committee Report. The Personnel Committee met on Monday, August 9, 2021. JP Lisa Ecke presented the Chairman's Report to the Committee. The Committee heard a presentation from Compensation Consultant Blair Johanson on increasing the County's salary ranges and merit based raises. The Committee approved to forward the recommendation of Option A to increase the County's salary ranges by 10% and give a 3.5% merit based raise to the Finance & Budget Committee.
