278 JP Patrick Deakins presented the October Finance & Budget Committee Report. The  
279 Finance & Budget Committee met Tuesday, October 12, 2021. There were reports  
280 given on the Treasurer, Employees' Insurance, and Comptroller. An ordinance  
281 appropriating \$350,000 from the Coronavirus Relief Fund to the pass through payments  
282 line item in the Coronavirus Relief Budget for 2021 was tabled indefinitely. The  
283 Committee also heard a presentation on the Central EMS from Chief Becky Stewart.  
284 The Committee approved nine ordinances to be forwarded to the Quorum Court.

286 JP Lance Johnson presented the October Jails/Law Enforcement/Courts Committee  
287 Report. The Jails/Law Enforcement/Courts Committee met on Monday, October 11,  
288 2021. There were Statistic Reports given on the Juvenile Detention Center, Sheriff's  
289 Enforcement, and Detention. The Committee received updates on Returning Home  
290 and Criminal Justice Coordinating Committee. The Committee approved an ordinance  
291 creating the position of Criminal Justice Coordinating Committee Coordinator to be  
292 forwarded to the Finance & Budget Committee. Sheriff Tim Helder discussed with the  
293 Committee an incentive program for the Detention Center.  
294

295 JP Lisa Ecke presented the October Personnel Committee Report. The Personnel  
296 Committee met on Monday, October 11, 2021. JP Lisa Ecke presented the Chairman's  
297 Report to the Committee. The Committee approved ordinances creating the position of  
298 Deputy Coroner and Criminal Justice Coordinating Committee Coordinator to be  
299 forwarded to the Finance & Budget Committee.

**WHEREAS,** that overly burdensome workload has been exacerbated by the COVID-19 pandemic; and,

**WHEREAS,** the Coroner request an appropriation to support one additional employee within his office.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM  
COURT OF WASHINGTON COUNTY, ARKANSAS:**

**ARTICLE 1.** There is hereby created one position of Deputy Coroner, Grade 17, in the Coroner Budget of the General Fund (10000419) for 2021.

**ARTICLE 2.** There is hereby appropriated the total amount of \$8,744 to the following salary line items in the Coroner Budget for 2021:

**WHEREAS**, County Ordinance No. 2017-44 established the Washington County Criminal Justice Coordinating Board (the "Board"), pursuant to A.C.A. § 14-14-705; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board is composed of local judges, correction officials, the prosecuting attorney, law enforcement officials, county officials, medical professionals, and mental health professionals; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board is charged with, among other duties: recommending protocols and reforms to ensure the efficient administration of the criminal justice system; assisting in the access, analysis, and transfer of pertinent data; analyzing data related to the effectiveness of local crisis intervention teams and of the Washington County Regional Crisis Stabilization Unit; and, providing the County with recommendations, supported by analysis, grounded in the Board's findings; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board has requested a Criminal Justice Committee Coordinator to help effectuate those duties.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM  
COURT OF WASHINGTON COUNTY, ARKANSAS:**


**ARTICLE 1.** There is hereby created the position of Criminal Justice Committee Coordinator, ungraded, at an annual salary of \$60,000, in the County Judge Budget of the General Fund (10000100) for 2021.

**ARTICLE 2.** There is hereby appropriated the total amount of \$28,251 to the following line items in the County Judge Budget for 2021:
