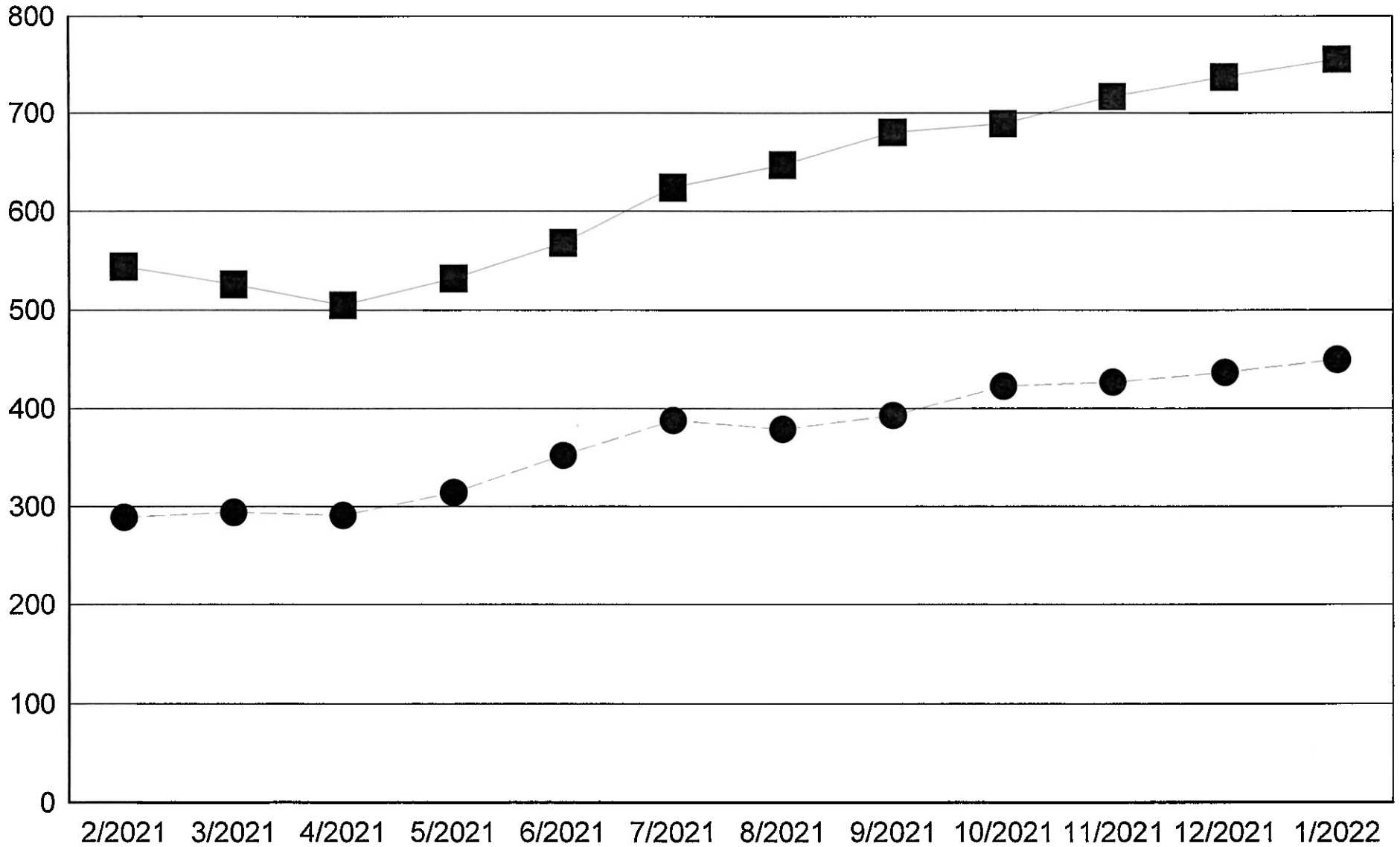

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF WASHINGTON, STATE OF ARKANSAS, A RESOLUTION TO BE ENTITLED:

A RESOLUTION OF THE QUORUM COURT OF WASHINGTON COUNTY, ARKANSAS EXPRESSING APPRECIATION TO DR. ROBERT KARAS AND KARAS CORRECTIONAL HEALTH.

WHEREAS, in December 2019, the SARS-COVID-19 disease spread from Wuhan, China, prompting a world-wide pandemic; and,

WHEREAS, while the numbers and effects of the virus have been largely exaggerated, hundreds of millions of people have been infected with the virus, resulting in millions of deaths worldwide, and thousands of deaths in Arkansas; and,

WHEREAS, the virus has caused particular hardships in correctional facilities around the globe with an estimated 0.5% death rate in the US; and,

WHEREAS, while over 850 cases of the infection have been recorded in the Washington County Detention Center, Dr. Robert Karas and Karas Correctional Health have effectively treated those cases which has resulted in zero fatalities from the virus.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF WASHINGTON COUNTY, ARKANSAS:

ARTICLE 1. The Washington County Quorum Court commends Dr. Robert Karas and Karas Correctional Health for a job well done despite the unique challenges of working in the Washington County Detention Center.

ARTICLE 2. The Washington County Quorum Court supports Dr. Robert Karas and Karas Correctional Health for the exceptional medical care given to detainees at the Washington County Detention Center.
