I am hereby filing an appeal of a recent decision of the Washington County Planning Board/ Zoning Board of Adjustments (ZBA). My appeal is being filed within thirty (30) days of the decision as required by Ordinances 2009-33, 43, 67, and 2010-02 amending Section 11-206; "Appeals from Board" in "Chapter 11-Planning and Development, Article VI-Zoning" in Washington County, Arkansas.

During the August 26, 2022 meeting of the Washington County Zoning Board of Adjustments, a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) was presented for approval. The CUP was for a (circle one) Commercial Use / Industrial Use / Residential Use / Other Use, located in Section 12, Township 17, Range 29, in Washington County.

My understanding of the decision of the Washington County ZBA is as follows:

J&J Concrete Pumping CUP (Planning project #2022-259, parcel #001-14930-004) is denied.

I am appealing this decision to the Quorum Court for the following reasons:

Washington County ZBA made an erroneous finding that a business is being operated out of the property, but to the extent this could be true, the ZBA wrongfully failed to grant a CUP. To rule in this manner would effectively mean that a plumber could not park his work truck in the driveway, a lawn care work could not call his employee to come park a car in the driveway and drive together to a location, or even technically allow a house cleaner to take calls for her business out of her home, get in her car in the driveway with cleaning supplies, and drive to a home to actually perform cleaning services. In addition, there was absolutely no evidence individuals on the property were there for work-related purposes, rather than personal.

I understand that the Quorum Court will follow the same procedures as the Washington County ZBA to reach a decision. The decision of the Quorum Court may be appealed to Circuit Court within thirty (30) days from said decision. I certify the above statements are correct to the best of my knowledge. ARTICLE 1. The Quorum Court of Washington County, Arkansas hereby adopts the annual budget for calendar year 2023, which is attached hereto. Said budget reflects the anticipated revenues of Washington County and the expenditures authorized for each department within each fund of said County, the number and compensation of deputies and County employees, and the compensation of County Officers.

ARTICLE 2. A copy of the 2023 Budget shall be on file in the County Clerk’s Office and shall be available for inspection and copying during normal business hours.

ARTICLE 3. The said 2023 Budget is hereby incorporated herein and adopted in full, and all expenditures reflected therein are authorized to be expended.

ARTICLE 4. Budget Controls. It is the responsibility of each elected official and/or department head to operate within the guidelines of the budget as adopted or amended by the Quorum Court. The guidelines are described in the following paragraphs:

42 The budget for each County department consists of appropriations of authorized

52 Expenditures will be limited to the amounts appropriated in the above categories.

54 Transfers in Personal Services categories or transfers between departments may

57 Grant funds are not subject to the restrictions in this paragraph. Line item transfers
58 within a departmental budget may be made within and into all categories, with the
59 exception of the Personal Services Category as outlined herein. Transfers going into or
60 out of the Capital Outlay Category shall not exceed \$20,000 per year in the General Fund,
