A RESOLUTION OF THE QUORUM COURT OF WASHINGTON COUNTY, ARKANSAS SUPPORTING EXCEPTIONS TO THE ARKANSAS TRIGGER LAW IN CASES OF RAPE AND INCEST.

WHEREAS, Act 308, the Arkansas Unborn Child Protection

WHEREAS various Republican, Democrat, and independent

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF WASHINGTON COUNTY, ARKANSAS:

ARTICLE 1. The Washington County Quorum Court hereby resolves to fully and robustly support exceptions in cases of rape and incest to Act 308, and to advocate our members of the General Assembly, the Governor and the members of the General Assembly as a whole, for the due consideration and adoption by the General Assembly and signing by the Governor of Arkansas, of legislation creating: abortion ban exceptions for pregnancies that result from rape as defined in § 5-14-103 or incest as defined in § 5-26-202; and respectfully encourage the legislation to be a legislative priority of the General Assembly and the Governor of the State of Arkansas.

The 17 current HVAC units to be replaced are over 15 years old and because the Sheriff's Office 18 is a 24/7 facility, these units have run approximately two to three times more than those 19 on a traditional office building. 20 21 WHEREAS, the Washington County Detention Center's 22 current surveillance system is old and outdated. The manufacturer of the current system 23 has discontinued the currently installed product line and will no longer support the 24 hardware or software past June 2023. 25 26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM 27 **COURT OF WASHINGTON COUNTY, ARKANSAS:** 28 29 ARTICLE 1.
