MEETING December 20, 2023 MINUTES

A meeting of the Fourth Judicial District Drug Task Force Control Board was held on December 20, 2023.

Chief Mike Reynolds called the meeting to order. Upon roll call, the above-listed members were acknowledged as present. Copies of the minutes from the November 29, 2023, meeting were distributed to all present. Sheriff Jay Cantrell made a motion, seconded by Chief Frank Gamble, to approve the minutes. The motion was approved unanimously.

A copy of the financial report for the Grant FY2023-2024 was distributed to all present for review, the period ending November 30, 2023. Willie Newman stated the total expense to date was \$310,975.00 which included State Set Aside \$56,559.00, State Drug Fund \$56,559.00, Local match of the State Set Aside \$25,099.00, Local Match of the Drug Fund \$7,516.00, and Non-Allowed-\$165,242.00.

Lieutenant Tim Franklin reported on the task force's activity from November 1, 2023, through November 30, 2023, and he distributed a copy of statistics to all present. Franklin stated that in November the task force opened 22 cases, closed 46 cases, and made 12 arrests. Franklin further noted that \$3,460.00 was expended for the purchase of evidence and \$0.00 for the purchase of information. Franklin stated that drugs seized during the month included: methamphetamine, marijuana, cocaine, psilocybin mushrooms, LSD, fentanyl, and pharmaceuticals. Franklin stated that 10 warrants were served. Also noted, were 11 drug convictions for November. The task force seized \$24,697.31 in U.S. currency during the month. The locations of DTF Enforcement Action for the month were Fayetteville 11 cases, Springdale 7 cases, Tontitown 1 case, Madison County 1 case, and Prairie Grove 2 cases.

OTHER BUSINESS

The drug task force submitted a request through the Department of Public Safety Equipment Grant for a TruNarc and was awarded over \$40,000.00 for the purchase, training, and 5-year warranty of that equipment. This award was presented to the City Fayetteville Council who approved to accept the grant.

TruNarc is a drug analyzer that provides a safer way to identify suspected narcotics.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Chief Mike Reynolds requested a date and time for the next meeting.
