

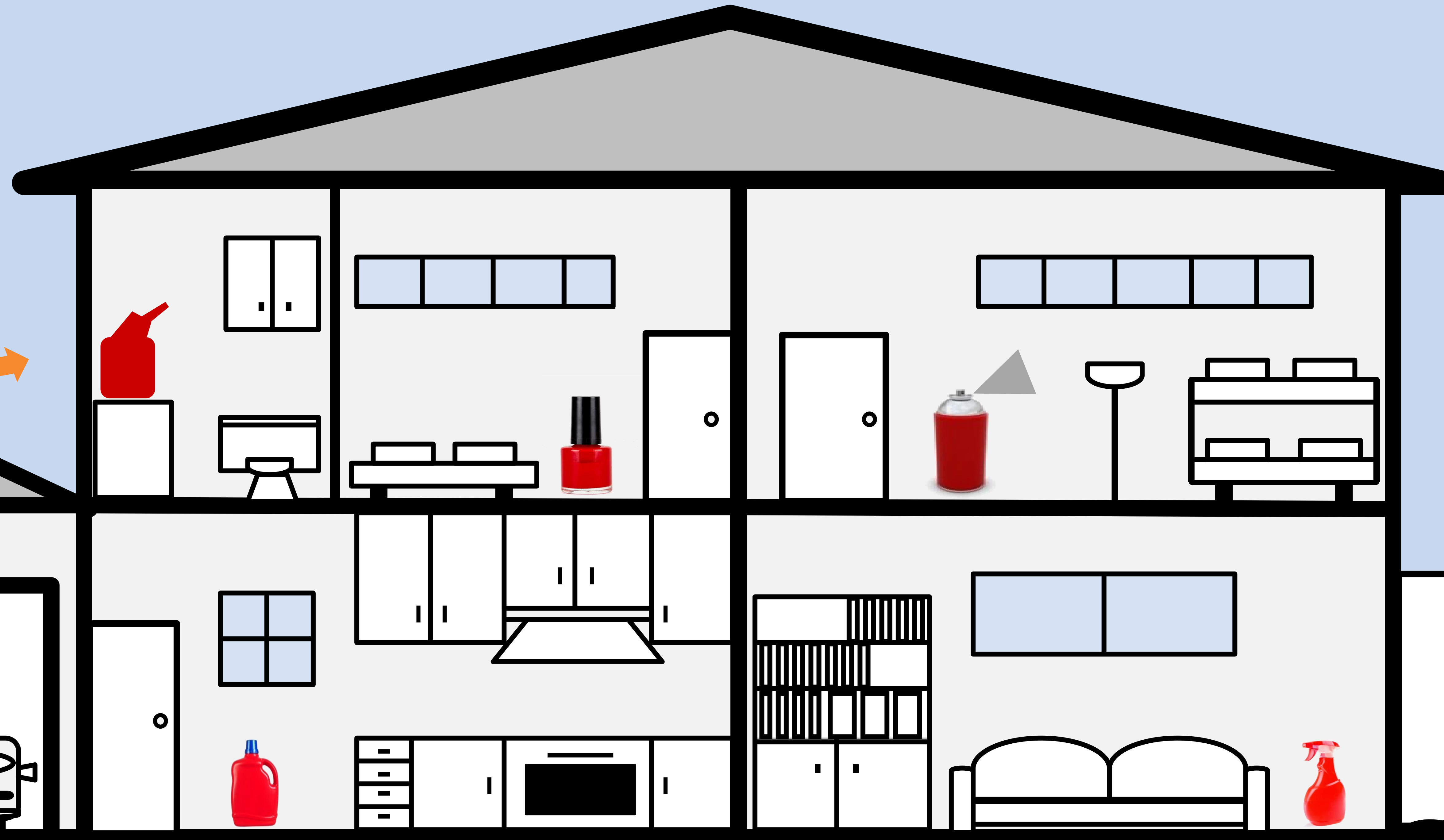
What's the Danger in Household Hazardous Waste?
