Ladies and Gentlemen: Last fall, we discovered that through a series of clerical errors that we may have failed to pay to the State's Department of Finance and Administration- specifically, the Administration of Justice Fund- monies generated from the filing fees from Trustee's Notices of Default and Intention to Sell (commonly known as non-judicial foreclosures). The potential liability for the County could be between \$500,000 and \$1 million.

The Treasurer's Office became aware of the existence of the problem last fall, but not its scope; the Judge's Office became aware late last week. The Treasurer's Office self-reported this issue to the State, and we have been awaiting confirmation from their personnel as to whether they believed DF&A was entitled to the money. Last week, they said they were entitled to reimbursement.

This problem predates any of the current incumbents in these offices (2008) and slipped the attention of State auditors for seven years. During that time, the Circuit Clerk's Office collected the filing fees, remitted them monthly to the Treasurer as Miscellaneous Fees and the Treasurer then put the money in the County General Fund under Miscellaneous Fees. A year-by-year breakdown of the amounts is attached to this memorandum. The Treasurer's Office and the Circuit Clerk's Office

have further, more detailed documentation for any Justice or member of the public who would like to see it.

You need to be informed that (a) we have corrected the problem with this particular fund so that the problem is not going to be an issue going forward; (b) we do not anticipate any other similar problems from any other funds; and (c) we are currently investigating the possibility of reducing the impact of this discovery in the form of a payment plan and/or forgiveness of some of the debt.

Each of us has acted in good faith to resolve this issue and was doing what each believed to be legal and right at the time we did it.

The Circuit Clerk and the Treasurer are available for question or comment.
